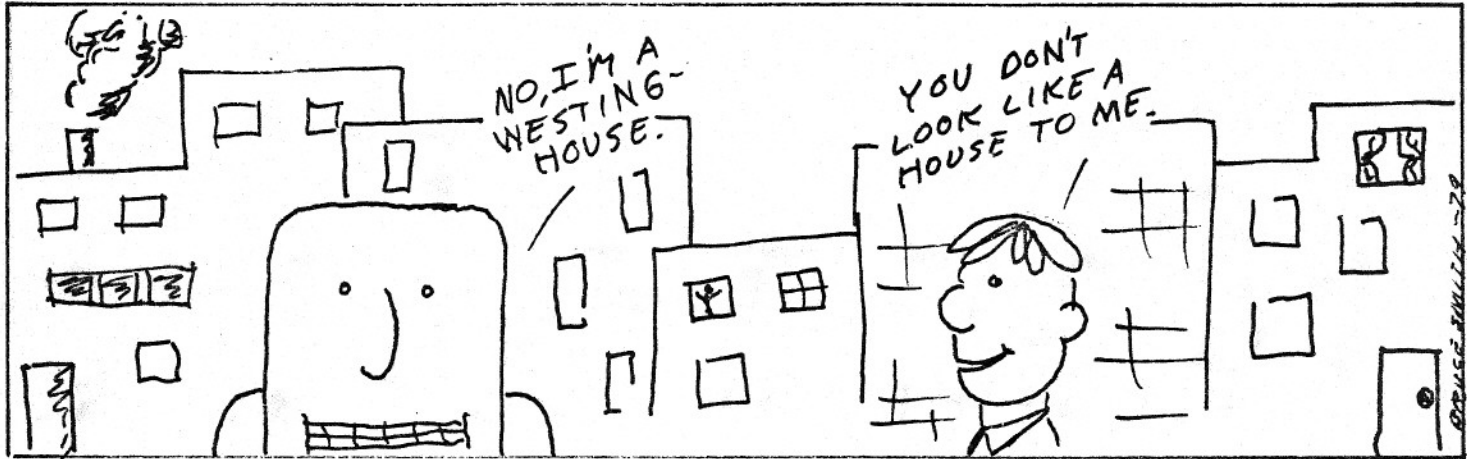

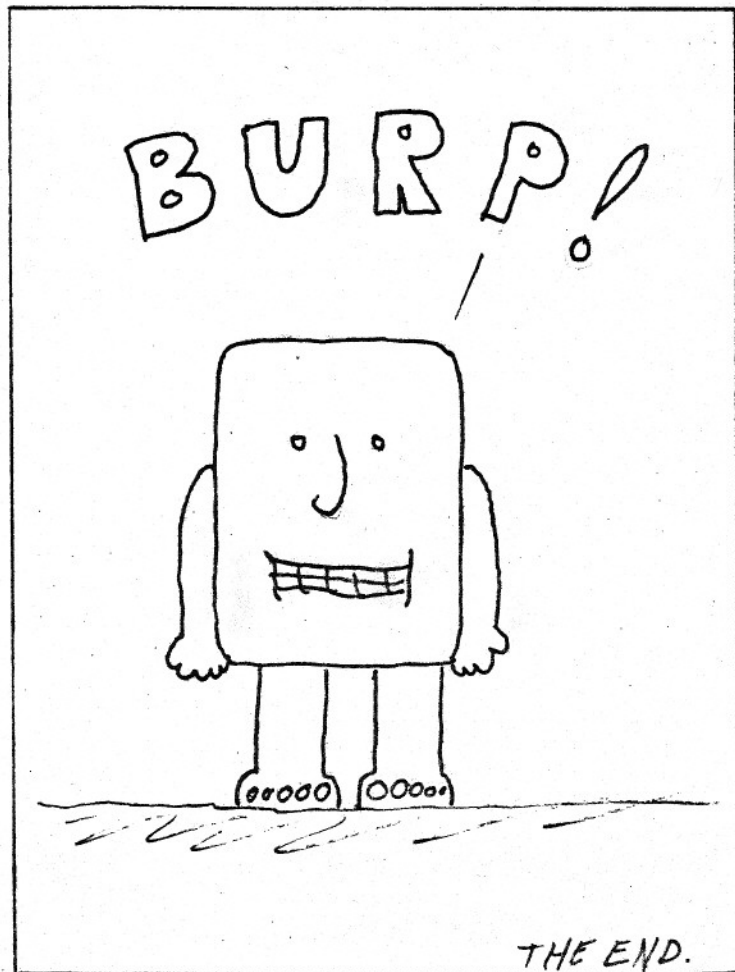
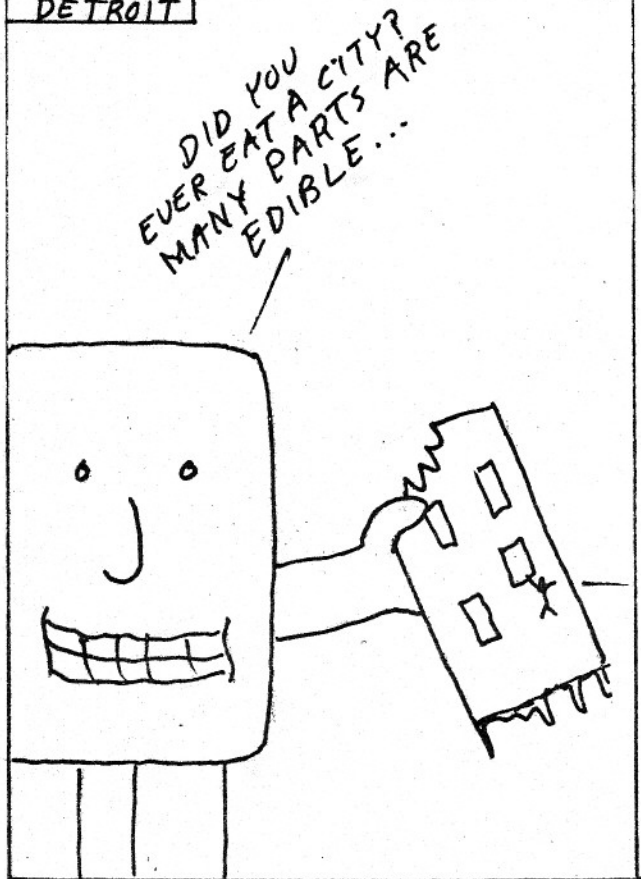
THE GIANT REFRIGERATOR THAT ATTACKED DETROIT.

I say, That bird is really hip.

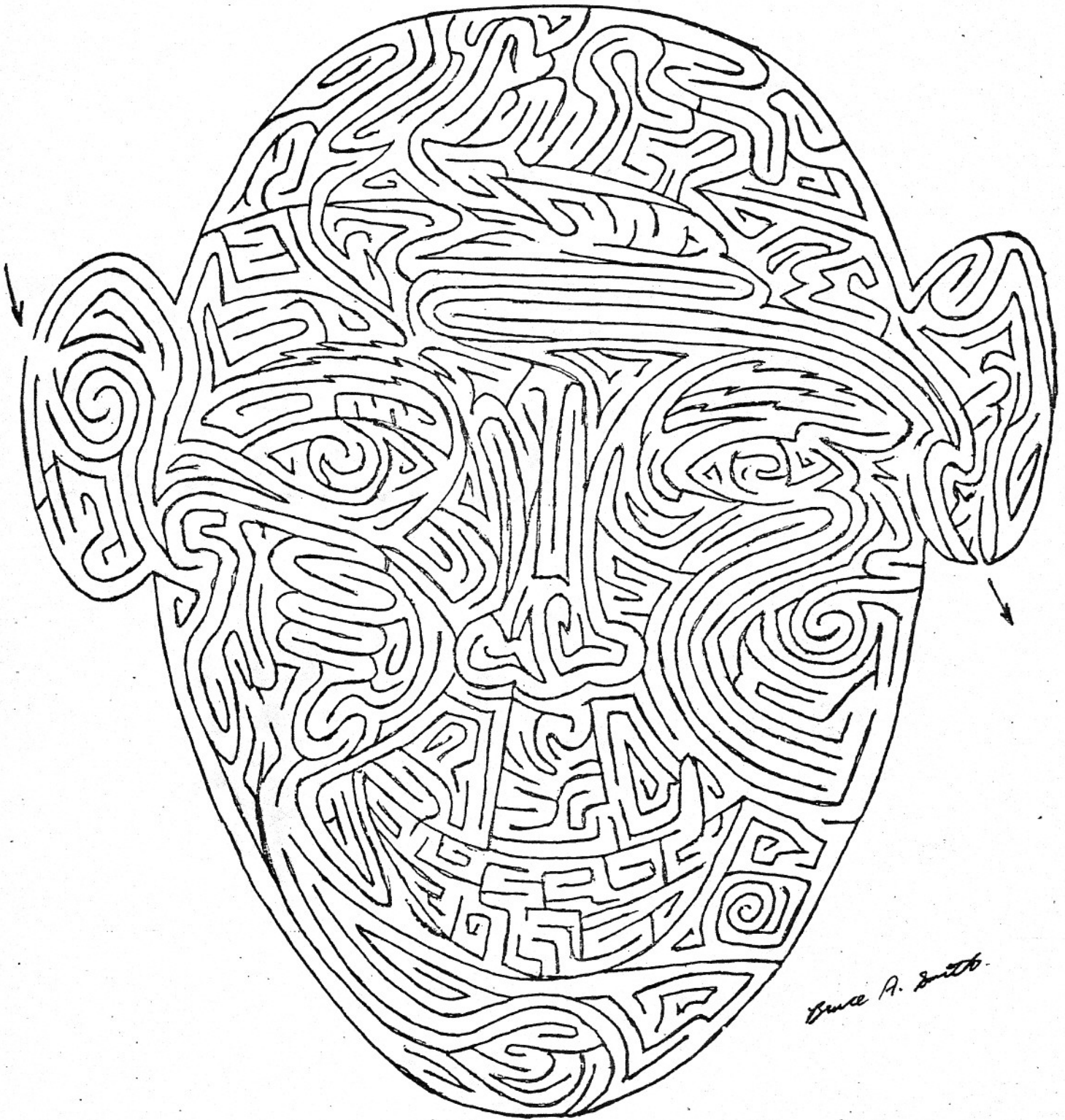
A bird starts nibbling on the bottom of Steve's foot.

IN ONE EAR AND OUT THE OTHER



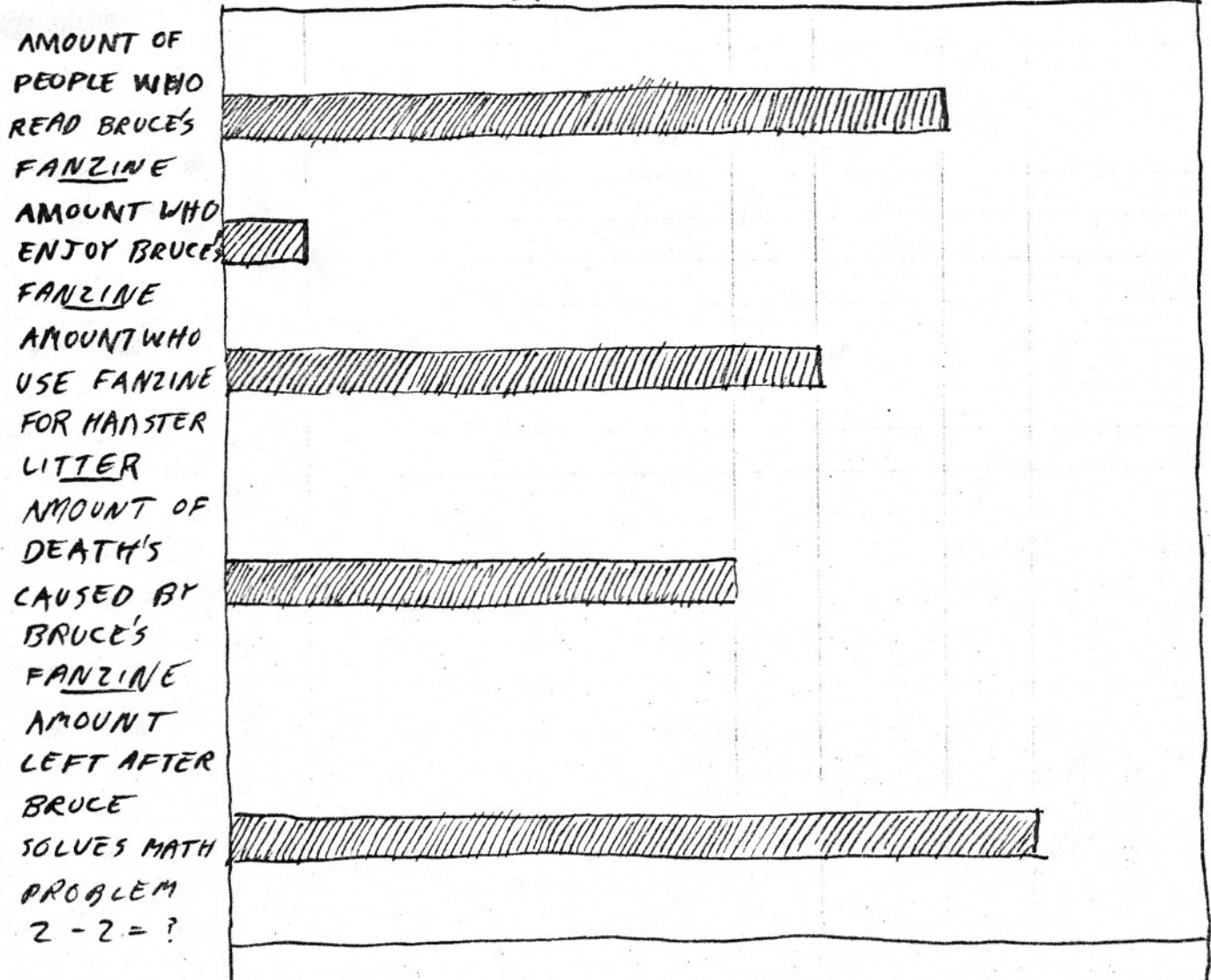

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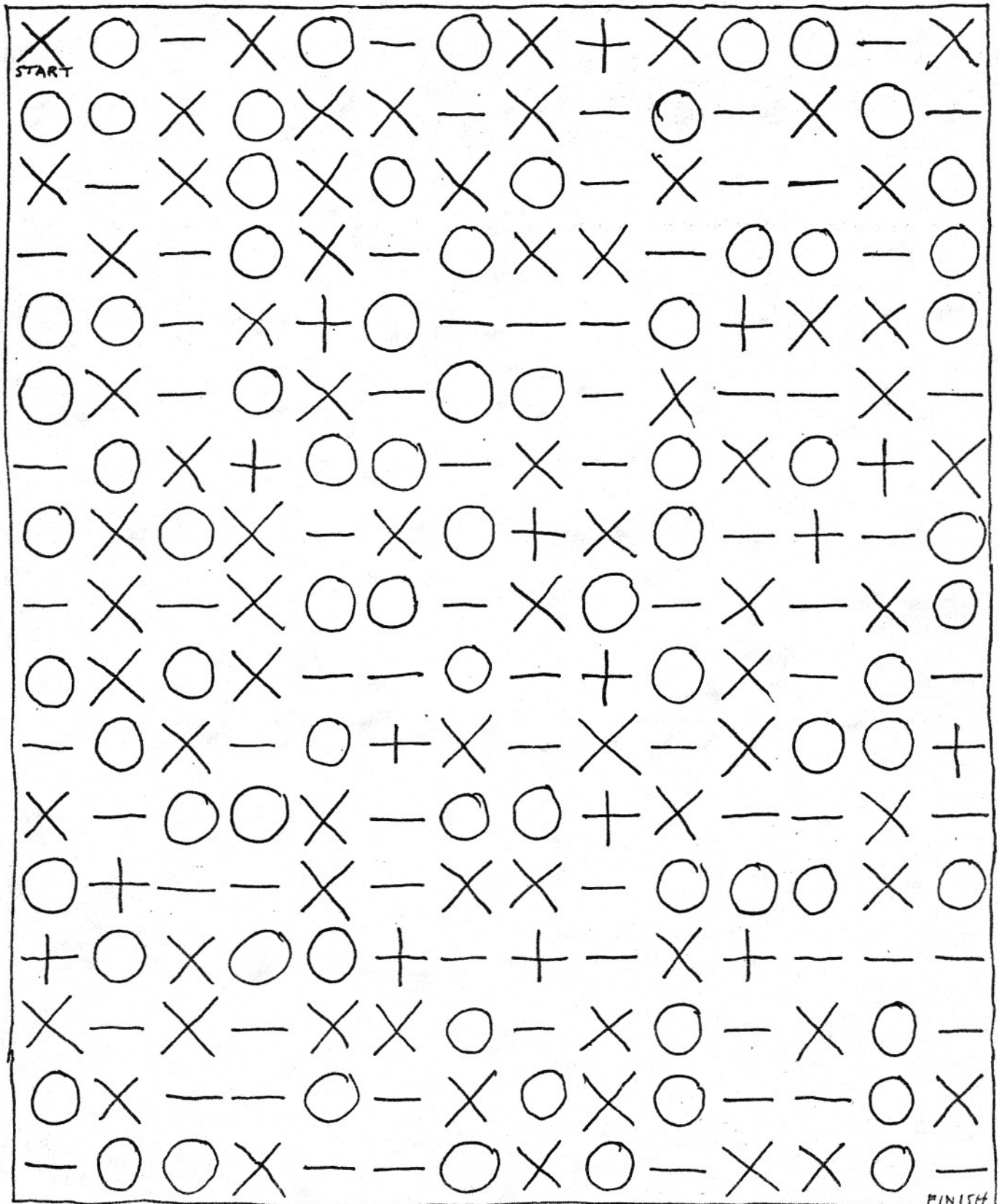
